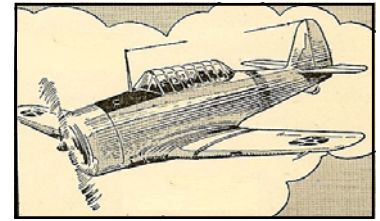

FLIGHT MANEUVER

WIND DRIFT CIRCLE

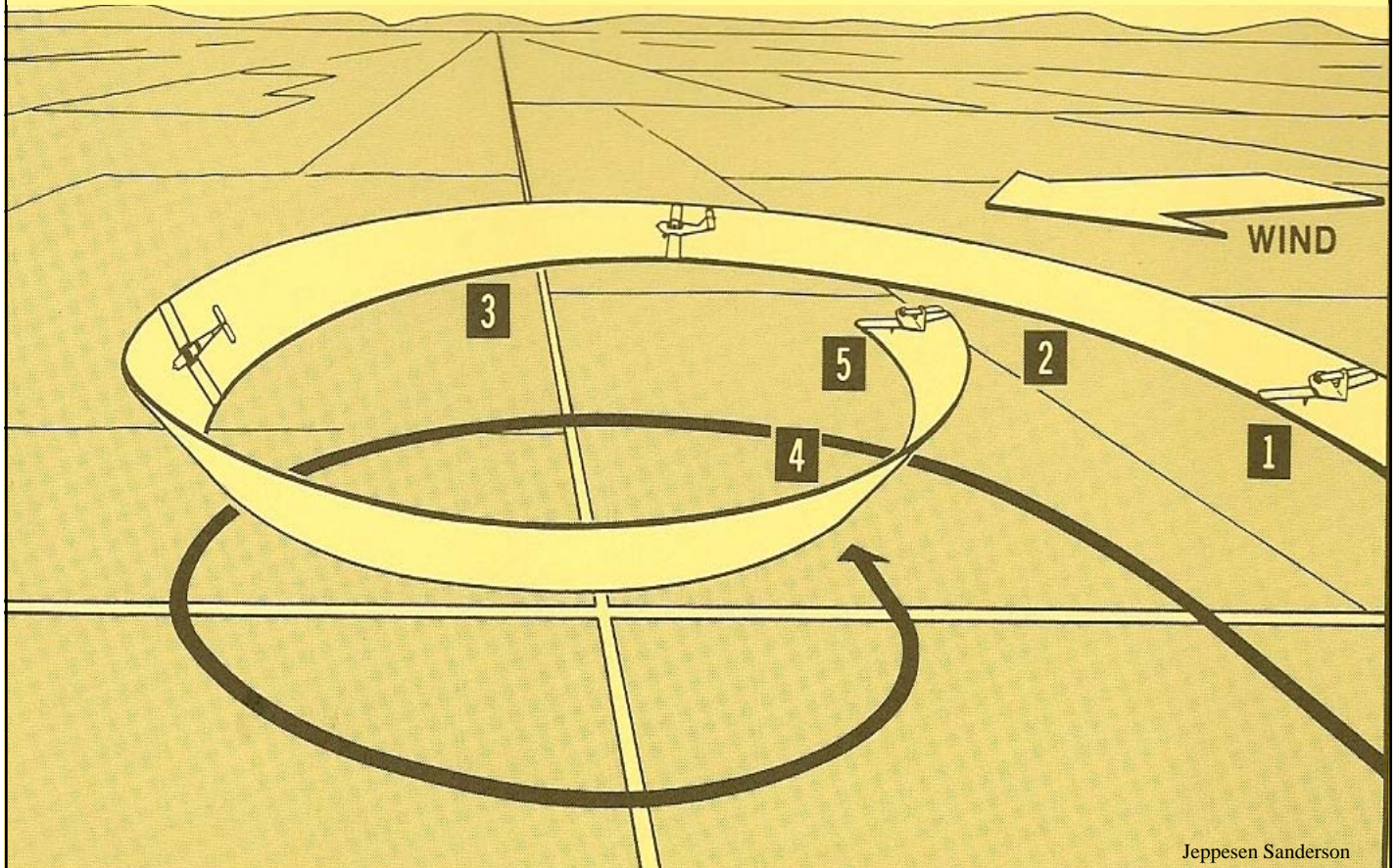
Remember, make clearing turns before any maneuver!

Altitude **1500'**

Airspeed **Cruise for aircraft**

ENTRY: Pick point or intersection, enter abeam

- 1 Bank angle — As desired
- 2 Turn — Begin abeam reference
- 3 Bank angle — Maintain constant for full circle
- 4 On roll-out — Note direction of drift from reference point
- 5 Wind direction — Blowing across reference in drift direction

Membership Meeting, Monday, February 11, 2013

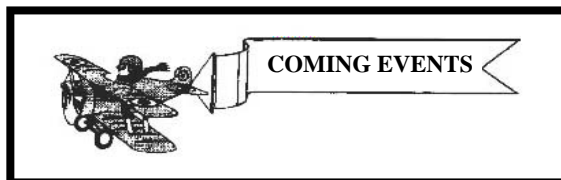
The meeting was held in the SIU AvTech classroom 145. At Carbondale Airport. The meeting was called to order by the president at 7:00 PM.
